Atlantic Kayak Tours Says: The Necky Zoar Sport is an inexpensive, very stable, over 14' kayak, so it meets our minimum on most programs. The reason 14' is so important is that the more flotation a kayak has the safer the kayak becomes. As boats get shorter the amount of flotation is reduced. While we think most people should buy a kayak that is over 15', in our experience 14' is the minimum to allow for a self rescue. Many people test paddle kayaks, but very few test rescue kayaks and we believe that everyone should. If you can't self rescue the kayak you are interested in, you should look for a different kayak. The Zoar Sport will fit the needs of many paddlers who are looking to primarily paddle in lakes, marshes, and easy rivers, with the occasional trip on the Hudson River. With good safety skills (check out the Canoe Safety Program), safety equipment and common sense the Zoar Sport will serve many paddlers well.

Necky Says: This 14 foot version of the Zoar retains the diamond hull and many of the paddling characteristics of its big brother. With its shortened length, the Zoar Sport is easier to handle both on and off the water. The Zoar Sport is the ideal coastal exploration boat for getting in and out of coves and harbors. The cockpit area remains unchanged, giving a good fit for everyone, and front and rear compartments provide good storage.
